の治 We, the undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Iowa Nonprofit Corporation Act under Chapter 338 of the Laws of the Sixty-First General Assembly (1965) adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

- I. The name of this corporation shall be The Cedar Amateur Astronomers, Incorporated.
- II. The period of this corporation's duration shall be perpetual.
- III. The purposes for forming and organizing this corporation are to:
 - Promote study and interest in astronomical 000NTY, 10WA topics within the membership and among the general public via dissemination of knowledge and ideas through lectures, meetings, displays, presentations, discussions, and outdoor activities.

Encourage and foster observational and computational work in astronomy.

Encourage communication and activities among the regional astronomical societies.

The address of this corporation's initial registered -office in the State of Iowa is 1513 Parkwood Lane, M.E. in the city of Cedar Rapids, Iowa; County of Linn. The name of it's initial registered agent at such address is Franklin L. Olsen.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any individual, and no part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or of participating or intervening in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office, or contacting or urging the public or members of a legislative body to propose, support, or oppose legislation, or advocating the adoption or rejection of legislation. This corporation shall not carry on as more than an insubstantial part of its activities any activity which is not in furtherance of its exempt purposes.

IX. Upon the dissolution or termination of this corporation, whether voluntary or involuntary, all property of the corporation shall be distributed by, and at the direction of, the Board of Directors to an Iowa college or colleges organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes which at that time qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or, in the absence of such an organization, to another organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes which at that time qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954. In no event shall said property be distributed to any officer or director of the corporation, or to any other person or persons whomsoever; provided, however, that the corporation shall have the right to pay and discharge such reasonable costs, expenses, and liabilities as may be incurred in furthering such purposes.

X. This corporation has been established as an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under

Gentlemen:

The Department has determined that under Iowa Code §422.34 your organization is exempt from Iowa Corporation Income Tax.

This determination is based principally on the fact that your organization has received exempt status from the Internal Revenue Service. You must inform the Iowa Department of Revenue, in writing, of the revocation of or any change in your exempt status by the IRS within thirty (30) days after the federal determination.

Iowa Corporation Income Tax returns are <u>not</u> required in the future, even if tax is imposed by the IRS on unrelated business income, as long as your exempt status remains unchanged. If revocation is imposed by the IRS, Iowa Corporation returns, tax and interest will automatically become due for the years exempt status was revoked.
